

HEALTH ADVOCATE AND WELLNESS NURSE

Congregation of Sisters of St. Agnes

The Congregation of Sisters of St. Agnes (CSA), a Roman Catholic religious order serving in the United States and Nicaragua, is seeking a full time Health Advocate and Wellness Nurse for the U.S.A. sisters. The office will be at the Motherhouse of CSA located in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin. The registered nurse serves in an advisory and consultative role for health and wellness services provided to the sisters on mission by outside entities. The role also provides a health resource for sisters in a local community/area who need support in caring for a sister with health needs. A key component of the position includes wellness education to promote self-responsibility and well-being with special attention to transitions required across the continuum of care. The role requires a compassionate and competent practitioner who is responsible for cultivating relationships with the sisters and demonstrates a respect for the religious way of life. A commitment to professional development in the fields of health care directly related to the needs of the sisters served and development of networks of professional contacts to enhance the effectiveness of services is required.

Qualifications:

1. Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing; Masters Degree in Nursing preferred.
2. Minimum of five years recent clinical experience in a combination of the following: woman's health, integrative health, aging, health promotion and wellness.
3. Valid license as a Registered Nurse in the State of Wisconsin.
4. Consults and collaborates with the U.S. regional coordinators to establish an informed understanding of the health needs of the sisters
5. Assists sisters in finding and utilizing health resources as needed; facilitating the acquisition of services that allow the sister to maintain independence, as appropriate
6. Serves as a sister's advocate when appropriate
7. Demonstrates ability to handle emergency health situations in a prompt, precise and professional manner
8. Demonstrates excellent interpersonal, organizational, verbal and written communication skills.
9. Maintains good physical and emotional health combined with a sense of humor
10. Demonstrates ability to work both collaboratively and independently.
11. Maintains confidentiality.
12. Has competence in computers and knowledge of Microsoft software.
13. Has a willingness to travel, as needed
