Sister Lucille Bertram, CSA, formerly Sister Clementine, died peacefully on October 25, 2012, at Nazareth Center.

Sister Lucille was born August 19, 1928, in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, to Clemens and Loretta Bertram. There were three girls and two boys in the family. Sister was professed on August 15, 1947. She received a CDA in dietary services and COTA in occupational therapy. Her ministries were homemaker and director of an occupational therapy group at a home for the mentally challenged; she began a literacy program for older adults in Milwaukee. She ministered in Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, Indiana, Illinois, and Ohio.
